



The Highland Entrepreneurship Youth Program is a 10-week summer program designed to provide high school students with the opportunity to create, plan, launch, and operate a business enterprise. With the help of a Project Manager and HEP mentors, teams of 4-5 students will work on business concepts.

HEP Mentors and the Project Manager will assist the teams through a 4-week business planning process. Students will have the chance to develop a product or service, plan operations, project financial statements, market the business, etc. Once the business planning process is complete, the team will launch their business July 1.

Each team will operate their business enterprise until the mid-August deadline. The Business Project Team that achieves the highest net profit is declared the competition's winner and will receive scholarship funds.
