Brush Pick-up



The City of Highland ceased monthly brush pickup in July of 2001. However, when a storm event causes wide spread damage the Director of Public Works may indicate that brush pickup by the Street and Alley Department is warranted. When this happens every attempt will be made to notify the public. Pickup will be for a limited period of time and residents should call the Public Works Department 654-6823 for a work order to be entered. Crews will not drive up and down alleys looking for piles of debris. All limbs must be moved to alley or curbside by the resident, crews are not

allowed to pickup off of private property. The City does not have a location where drop off of debris is available, so it is important that residents call for a work order.

Any other time that you have limbs or yard waste it will be removed by our contracted trash haulers. Limbs no larger than 4 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length should be bundled for pickup. Other yard waste can be placed in a garbage can with a red X or in kraft paper bags for pickup. Any issues with trash pick should be addressed to City Hall 654-9891.

Due to the storm on the afternoon of May 26, 2010, the Department of Public Works has determined that the Street and Alley Division will be collecting storm related tree debris until Friday June 4th.

Please move debris to alley or curbside then call the Public Works Department at 654-6823 to have your debris removed.

Pickup will continue through Friday, June 4.

PW-03-10—Main Street Parking Lots
