Dear Men's League Representative,

Please find included a schedule for the 2007/08 Men's Basketball League. For those of you unfamiliar with the school's gyms, the games will be played in the Upper Elementary Gym, or for the old-timers, the old Jr. High.

You will notice an abundant amount of nights off. This is due to the fact that the school has school related functions either scheduled or tentatively scheduled. However, all teams will get 10 games.
