Staff Reports:

- Director Rosen updated the commission on the Old City Lake spillway. He also stated that a
 couple of other projects are being worked on to take advantage of the lake's low level. One
 project would be to replace the culvert between the "Bargetzi Lake" and Old City Lake. This is
 being recommended because once the spillway is complete, the water level will be higher and
 will back water up to the east side of the road. The existing culvert is not working properly now
 and would present an issue in the future.
- Rosen continued by informing the commission that the bass were released into Silver Lake from the brood pond. Results show a 33% survival rate, which, according to Fred Cronin, IDNR Fish Biologist, is a good percentage. A total of 1,627 total fish, averaging 5.75" and 2 oz. were released.
- 2024 meeting dates were approved for the third Thursday of March, July, & October to be held in the Korte Recreation Center @ 7:00PM

Guests:

- Director Rosen was asked if/when the kayak kiosk would be closing. He stated that a call has been made to put them into "hibernation" before November 1st.
- Josh Kirchoff requested that the trailer stickers return because his father was issued a warning ticket for not having his mirror tag. Based on the fact that they share a boat and have different vehicles, he thought a trailer sticker would help with that issue.

Requests/comments from commission members:

• Bill B. said that he likes to ask lake users he sees how they like the lake and park. He stated that the overwhelming comments are that the lake is beautiful and the park is always so well kept.
